- 1. After the meeting on 1 February 2011, when did the Steel Industry Innovation Council hold its next meeting?
- 2. What was on the agenda of the meeting, and how long did it last?
- 3. Have there been any other meetings of the Steel Industry Innovation Council since that time? If so, on what dates?

## **ANSWER:**

- 1. 12 September 2011.
- 2. The meeting lasted for one hour. The agenda comprised:
  - Introduction of the new Chair;
  - A discussion of the current state of the industry, including the recent announcements by both companies (BlueScope Steel and OneSteel) to restructure their businesses and the Government's response;
  - Introduction of the new Steel Supplier Advocate, and discussion of the Buy Australia at Home and Abroad program; and
  - Discussion of the Steel Industry Innovation Council's forward work program.
- 3. The Steel Industry Innovation Council met on 24 November 2011. The agenda comprised:
  - Discussion on the current state of the industry;
  - Structural adjustment in the steel industry (The Illawarra Stakeholder Taskforce and Illawarra Region Innovation and Investment Fund, and activities on the Mornington Peninsula;
  - Update on Government policy initiatives (changes to Australian Industry Participation and the Prime Minister's Manufacturing Taskforce);
  - Update on the Steel Transformation Plan;
  - Progress report on the Steel Council's Working Group's activities against the milestones and its forward program for 2012.
