**Senator Bushby asked:**

How much was spent by each department and agency on the government (Ministers/Parliamentary Secretaries) stationery requirements in your portfolio (i.e. paper, envelopes, with compliments slips) in 2010-11?

**Answer:**

In 2010-11, the only Ministerial stationery for which the ATO paid, was for 1,000 DL sized envelopes for the Assistant Treasurer and Minister for Financial Services and Superannuation. These were purchased in December 2010 at a cost of \$301.82.

All other stationery requirements for the Treasury portfolio Ministers were provided by the Treasury. All details of these costs will be included in Treasury's response to this question.
