QUESTION No.: SI-103

- 1. How was the membership decided and who made the offers to each of the people chosen to be members, how and when?
- 2. Was remuneration or benefits of any kind given to any of the members of the Taskforce and, if so, in what form?
- 3. How many people declined the invitation to be members of the Taskforce?

ANSWER

- 1. Membership was decided by the Government. Prospective members were contacted during October 2011 by telephone by Ministerial staff.
- 2. Members of the Taskforce were not remunerated. Arrangements were put in place to reimburse the non-Government members of the Taskforce for reasonable travel and accommodation expenses related to the work of the Taskforce.
- 3. The Department is not aware of any person declining the invitation to be a member of the Taskforce.
