- 3. What the breakdown of these estimates is between administered and Departmental costs?
- 4. How many FTE staff positions are allocated to the running of Expediting Clinical Trial Reform in Australia?

ANSWER

- 1. Actual administered expenditure for 2012-13 was \$100,000.
- 2. For the administered program expenses refer to the table on page 46 of the *Industry*, *Innovation, Climate Change, Science, Research and Tertiary Education Portfolio Budget Statements 2013-14*, unless the program was impacted by measures reported in the 2013-14 Mid-Year Economic and Fiscal Outlook, whereby the revised program estimates will be available in the Industry Portfolio Additional Estimates Statements 2013-14.
- 3. The estimates referenced in answer 2 are for administered expenses only. The Department does not generally maintain details of the breakdown of departmental costs by program.
- 4. Allocation of staff to departmental programmes is not available as staff work on multiple programmes and tasks depending on priorities and workload.
