## In relation to Simplot:

- 1. Has the Department briefed the Coalition Government on Simplot's business case for government co-investment to upgrade their plants?
- 2. When did the Department brief the Government on Simplot's situation?
- 3. Did the Department convey the company's urgency for a decision from government?
- 4. Has the Department done any further work on potential support measures for Simplot?
- 5. Has the Department done any analysis or modelling of the regional economic effects on growers should Simplot close its Devonport and/or Bathurst plants?
- 6. Has the Department done any preliminary work or provided any advice as to whether a transition package would be needed should Simplot cease operations? (If yes) What are your preliminary conclusions and recommendations?

## ANSWER

- 1. Simplot has not submitted a request to the Government for co-investment to upgrade its facilities.
- 2. The Department has provided briefing including for a meeting the Minister had with Simplot.
- 3. The Minister was provided with advice regarding Simplot's operating conditions.
- 4. & 5. As Simplot has not submitted a request for potential support measures, no further work has been undertaken.
- 6. On 24 October 2013 Simplot announced it would downsize both its Bathurst and Devonport plants. It also announced investment of \$25 million over three years at its Devonport plant without government assistance.
