**QUESTION No.:** SI-74

1. Since its inception, how many grants have been awarded through the Clean Technology suite of programs?
  - What is the value of these grants?
  - What is the breakdown across the different programs?
2. As at 7 September 2013:
  - How many applicants were there to the Clean Technology programs?
  - Provide a breakdown of the various stages of these applications (e.g. contracted, approved but no contract, assessed but not approved, not assessed etc.).
3. Since 7 September 2013:
  - Have any contracts for the Clean Technology Programs been executed?
  - Have any grants been processed? If so, what is the value of those grants?
  - Have any offers been withdrawn or contracts broken?

**ANSWER**

1. Number and value of grants awarded as at 30 November 2013:

3. In the period 7 September to 30 November 2013 no contracts have been executed, no grants processed, no offers withdrawn and no contracts broken.
