**Answer:**

The 'Other' category includes items that do not easily fit into the existing categories and sub-categories. Examples of more innovative use under this category include:

- Child care to enable job seeker to attend work/interview
- Purchase of passport photos (eg to accompany job applications)
- Purchase of birth certificates
- Reimbursement for dental work
- Alarm clock
- Eye glasses
