Question:

Senator Carr – I am just thinking about the numbers of recommendations you have made to the minister, in the period when he has been the minister. He has chosen to reject three in humanities, and you do not want to tell me which three they are.

Dr Walker – I think the numbers you indicated were more or less correct.

Senator Carr – You do not want to tell me which three they are?

Professor Høj – We would prefer not to.

Senator Carr – I ask you to put that on notice, and I want to know the reasons why you will not provide that information.

Professor Høj – We will take that on notice.

Senator Carr – Will you take that on notice and provide reasons as to why you will not provide that information to this committee?

Professor Høj – Yes, and I have indicated to you that we believe that we need to protect the identity of the unsuccessful applicants.
