Answer:

University of Newcastle plagiarism case

- a) The matter has been discussed as part of the Institutional Assessment Framework and also with the new Vice-Chancellor, Professor Saunders.
- b) The University of Newcastle has advised the Department of Education, Science and Training of its ongoing measures to improve the identification and handling of plagiarism allegations.
- c) No.
- d) If the ICAC report is made publicly available, yes.
- e) and f) This depends on the recommendations made in the report and whether any action for the Department arises from consideration of them.
- g) and h) No, because AUQA's responsibilities do not include investigating specific complaints about individual universities.
- i) The AUQA will consider quality improvements made in the University's policies and procedures for offshore programs through its standard follow-up monitoring of the implementation of audit report recommendations as well as in subsequent audits.
