Latrobe Aquifer Study

The study was initiated by a stakeholder group which met in Sale, Victoria on 19 September 2003. Participants included the Minister for Science, the Hon. Peter McGauran MP, representatives from the Victorian Farmers Federation, Geoscience Australia, Bureau of Rural Sciences, Esso, the Loy Yang Power Station, and representatives from Victorian Government agencies. CSIRO was invited to the meeting at the initiative of the Minister.

The Minister did not commission CSIRO to undertake this study. During one of their regular meetings Dr Garrett and the Minister discussed whether CSIRO might undertake such a study. Following an assessment involving the Directors of the Wealth from Oceans and Water for a Healthy Country Flagships, CSIRO decided to undertake the study because it considered that it would address a set of interesting and important research questions of ongoing community interest.
