Communications Staff Current and 2002, 2003, 2004

- Following the development and subsequent Board endorsement of the CSIRO Communications Strategy in 2003, a review was commenced of the Corporate Communications function and structure.
- Based on the outcomes of the review, a decision was made to restructure the function to align it more closely with delivery of the Strategy.
- A number of new communication activities were established (CSIRO.au, Brand and Marketing, Flagship Communications, Social Responsibility and Ethics) and this resulted in the variance in staff numbers between June 2004 and February 2005.
