Answer:

CSIRO has provided the following response.

Global Research Alliance - Staff

CSIRO has not engaged any staff specifically to support the Global Research Alliance (GRA). Two existing staff, Dr Vijoleta Braach-Maksvytis – Director CSIRO Global Development and Dr Peter Osman – Operations Manager CSIRO Global Development, provide support to CSIRO's involvement with the GRA amongst their various duties.

An assessment of the total time on work associated with the GRA is as follows:

2002-03:	6.3% of a full time equivalent staff (FTE) member per annum
2003-04:	9% of a full time equivalent staff (FTE) member per annum
2004-05:	9% of a full time equivalent staff (FTE) member per annum

This does not include work on GRA projects by CSIRO scientists.
