- a) Was Dr Phillips chosen to attend a Harvard management course during 2004?
- b) What were the dates, duration of the course and the total cost of his attendance?
- c) How long after his return was his employment terminated?

## Dr Neil Phillips

- a) Dr Phillips was chosen to attend the Advanced Management Program at Harvard in Boston in 2004, continuing a long tradition of CSIRO Chiefs participating in the program as part of their development. The course had proved valuable in providing a broad understanding of the latest management systems and strategies as well as exposure to a network of senior managers in a range of other organisations.
- b) The program commenced on 30 March 2004 and concluded on 27 May 2004. The total cost of Dr Phillips' attendance was \$A82,416 and this was paid by CSIRO's Exploration and Mining Division.
- c) Dr Phillips' position as Chief of CSIRO Exploration and Mining was terminated four months after his return from Harvard.
