Tutorial Voucher Initiative

The Tutorial Voucher Initiative was introduced by the Australian Government as a pilot programme to assist parents of children who were below the Year 3 national reading benchmark in 2003. As the Initiative is a pilot, it is limited to this defined group of students.

The pilot will be independently evaluated this year. The evaluation will run concurrently with the pilot.

Any extension to the Initiative will be a matter for future consideration by the Australian Government.
