Senator Carr provided in writing.

Question:

Can DEST confirm that the corresponding figures for total Indigenous higher education students are 27% (1994 – 2003) and -3% (1999-2003)?

Answer:

Indigenous Students

Between 1994 and 2003 total Indigenous enrolments increased by 21.3%. Between 1999 and 2003 total Indigenous enrolments decreased by 5.0%.

The data used to answer this question are from the National Higher Education Statistics collection, compiled by DEST with cooperation from the Australian Bureau of Statistics. In 2002 DEST moved to new definitions for total and commencing students in its collection. The new definition is based on a unique count of students enrolled in a twelve month period whereas the old methodology was a unique count of students at the 31 March census date.

This response uses the old definition data because it maintains a consistent time series between 1994 and 2003. It should be noted that data based on the old definition will not be the same as new definition data provided in some other publications such as the annual National Report to Parliament on Indigenous Education and Training.
