The following table lists the total Fee-for-Service (FFS) payments (GST exclusive) paid to the six organisations identified in Question on Notice E389_05 as having affiliation with the Australian Chamber of Commerce and Industry as well as share of the total FFS paid in those periods.

All data is sourced from DEST's Training and Youth Internet Management System (TYIMS) database as at 11 March 2005. TYIMS is DEST's management information system for making payments through the New Apprenticeships Incentives Programme and the New Apprenticeships Support Services contracts. Data extracted from this system is not reported to a statistical standard and as such is not made publicly available.
