Question:

How many Catholic and Independent schools (excluding special schools) will not be funded through the SES model from 2005-08? Please provide a breakdown by year and sector.

Answer:

Catholic and Independent Schools – SES Model

From 1 January 2005, all non-government schools will be funded under the SES funding arrangements.

The table below shows the number of schools, by year and sector, that will not be funded on their 2005-2008 SES score:

However, based on estimated 2005 supplementation, which is determined in October 2005, 167 schools are expected to move onto SES funding according to their 2005-2008 SES score.
