Can the Department advise what proportion of parents attending a participation interview were assisted with referral to a return to work program, a jet program, child care, rehabilitation, Job Network or education and training or other?

#### Answer:

For the period 20 September 2004 to 26 November 2004, 25.3 per cent of people on parenting payment single plus parenting payment partnered attending participation interviews were referred to Australian Government participation programmes. See following table:
