Can we have figures on overall numbers of NSA and YA incapacitated in 2003-04, and to March 2005, plus an additional breakdown by age and gender for the periods listed.

Answer:

There is no NSA or YA incapacitated payment type. NSA or YA jobseekers may be granted a temporary exemption from the activity test on the grounds of incapacity where they lodge a supporting medical certificate.

The table below provides overall numbers of NSA and YA recipients with a temporary exemption on the grounds of incapacity for 2003-04 and to March 2005, including a breakdown by age and gender.
