What is the profile of current DSP recipients by disability, age, sex, statistical local area or local government area, employment status and income?

**Answer:**

Please see attached tables for information on DSP recipients as at June 2004 by:

- age and gender;
- medical condition;
- employment status (earners vs non-earners) and ranged income from employment\*; and
- statistical local area.

\* Information on non-employment income is not available.

Notes:

The information on income from employment is from a different source with slightly different business rules and so the total population is different.

Due to confidentiality provision cells with less than 20 recipients have been replaced with '<20'. This includes cells that have a value of zero. If the total column makes it possible to work out the value of any '<20' cells, the total field has been left blank.

Data by SLA is based on concurring postcode data into 2001 ABS SLA groupings. It excludes DSP recipients with invalid postcodes and there is a small residual error due to rounding.
