Senator Wong asked in writing:

How many (a) DSP recipients and (b) other income support recipients with a disability were on the books of the following employment assistance programs at a given point in time in the last year (calendar or financial)?

- Open Employment Services (excludes Business Services);
- Job Network Intensive Support;
- Job Network Intensive Support Customised Assistance;
- Personal Support program; and
- Commonwealth Rehabilitation Service.

**Answer:**

The answer reflects data as at 30 June 2004, except for Intensive Support and Intensive Support Customised Assistance participant numbers which are as at 25 March 2005.
