Question:

Non-government schools: funding types

a) At the hearings on Wednesday, 15 February 2006, Mr Evans provided information on the number of non-government schools by funding types as at 18 January :

Funding maintained: Catholic systemic Independent schools	971 207
Funding guaranteed: Independent schools	183
Funded at SES rate: Catholic systemic Independent schools	642 668

Making a total of 2,671 non-government schools. (Hansard, 15 February 2006 EWRE 113)

Please confirm these figures.

- b) Please clarify if non-government special schools, receiving the maximum general recurrent grants, are included in these figures and, if so, under which of the above categories.
- c) Please provide information on the number of primary and secondary students in each of the above categories (including special schools separately).
- d) Please list the names, SES scores and primary and secondary enrolments of the non-government schools catering for students with emotional, social and behavioural difficulties that are described as 'special assistance schools' in the Schools Assistance (Learning Together Achievement through Choice and Opportunity) Amendment Bill 2006.
- e) Please list the schools that have moved from the 'funding maintained' category since the end of the 2001-2004 quadrennium, including the following information:
 - i. Names of schools
 - ii. Primary and secondary enrolments
 - iii. SES scores
 - iv. Funding levels; per capita and total;
 - v. % AGSRC paid (if different from their SES score, with explanation of any difference
 - vi. Explanation of each school's circumstances (e.g. closure; amalgamation; moving to a system, etc)

Answer:

Non-Government School Funding

- a) The information provided by Mr Evans on 15 February 2006 on the number of nongovernment schools by funding types for 2005 is correct as at 18 January 2006.
- b) The figures provided by Mr Evans in question (a) include independent and Catholic systemic Special Schools in the "Funded at SES rate" category. Please refer to attached Table 1.

- d) A 'special assistance school' is a non-government school in a State or Territory that has been, or is likely to be, recognised by the State Minister as a school that primarily caters for students with social, emotional or behavioural difficulties.

Special assistance schools will be determined after the Schools Assistance (Learning Together – Achievement through Choice and Opportunity) Amendment Bill 2006 has been enacted.

e) Please refer to attached Table 2. Thirty schools moved from the 'funding maintained' category since the end of the 2001-2004 funding quadrennium because their 2005-2008 SES scores resulted in their total school SES funding being greater than their total school year 2000 funding.
