Question:

The SIP document states that CSIRO conducted a Manufacturing Review of the \$120m spent directly on manufacturing research and \$100m spent on "research that has some relevance to manufacturing."

"CSIRO's Manufacturing Review has identified the need for some immediate change in our investment profile and additional change is foreshadowed in the future." (p.6)

(a) Are there any recommendations in the Review regarding the <u>Woodville laboratories</u>? What are they?

(b) Does CSIRO intend to keep them as they are or will any projects or staff be cut? Does CSIRO intend to sell the Woodville laboratories?
