#### **Question:**

What programmes are funded under IESIP?

#### **Answer:**

*Programmes funded under IESIP*

Following the passage of the *Indigenous Education (Targeted Assistance) Amendment Act 2004* in December 2004 funding for the Indigenous Education Strategic Initiatives Programme and the Indigenous Education Direct Assistance programme (IEDA) was appropriated under the IETA Act from 1 January 2005. This amendment also appropriated funding under the IETA Act for the Indigenous Youth Leadership programme and Indigenous Youth Mobility programme and a subsequent amendment in December 2005 appropriated funding for tutorial support for remote Indigenous students.

As a consequence the following programme elements are appropriated under IETA for the 2005 – 2008 funding quadrennium:

- Supplementary Recurrent Assistance (SRA)
- English as a Second Language – Indigenous Language Speaking Students (ESL-ILSS)
- Indigenous Education Projects
- 'Mixed-mode' Away-from-Base Assistance (AFB)
- Indigenous Tutorial Assistance Scheme (ITAS)
  - In-class Tuition
  - Year 10, 11 and 12 Tuition
  - Tertiary Tuition
  - Remote Indigenous Students (RIS)
- Whole of School Intervention Strategy (WoSI)
  - Parent School Partnerships Initiative (PSPI)
  - Homework Centres (HWC)
- Indigenous Youth Leadership programme (IYLP)
- Indigenous Youth Mobility programme (IYMP)
