Question:

What effect will the withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the Anglo-Australian Telescope have on the Anglo-Australian Telescope Board's (AATB) budget and functioning?

Answer:

Financial viability of the Anglo-Australian Telescope (AAT)

- The UK's contributions will be reduced gradually until 2010 when the facility becomes wholly Australian-owned. This is not expected to have a significant effect on the AATB's functioning in that period.
- The Review of the Anglo-Australian Observatory announced on 8 February 2006 will make recommendations on funding and governance arrangements post-2010.
