Senator Wong asked in writing:

Welfare to Work evaluation – What will the evaluation strategy cover? Will DEWR provide a) timely release of data on numbers of people in different categories affected by the changes? b) Data on what payments/employment assistance they receive? c) Data on short and longer term labour market outcomes (eg what % of the year do they rely mainly on income support rather than income from employment?)

## **Answer:**

The evaluation strategy for Welfare to Work is currently being developed. It is a matter for decision by the Government as to what, if any, administrative data on Welfare to Work would be made publicly available.
