Is the ABCC allowed to tap telephone conversations or other remote communications including email? If so by what process is authorisation to record obtained? **a**) Is it similar to current obligations placed on the AFP? **b**) Must they obtain a warrant from judge or Administrative Review Tribunal?

Answer:

• Under the *Telecommunications (Interception) Act 1979,* the ABCC is not an agency permitted to obtain a warrant to tap telephone conversations or other remote communications including email.
