**Question:**

Senator Siewert asked in writing:

What are the total number of summons issued to workers and, of the total, how many summons have been served on people other than the worker in question?

**Answer:**

- As at 3 March 2006, a total of 21 notices to attend and answer questions have been served on persons by the ABCC.
- The notices were served in the following manner:
  - Nine by delivering the notice to the person personally.
  - Eight by leaving the notice at the address of the place of residence of the person.
  - One by leaving the notice at the address of the place of business of the person.
  - Two by facsimile by prior arrangement with the person. Personal service was effected later.
  - One by serving the solicitor of the person.
