**Outcome:** Workplace Relations laws are enforced in building and construction industry workplaces

**Question:**

Senator Siewert asked in writing:

Do you believe that it is appropriate to provide information in a summons or notice to appear that pertains to the matter on which a worker is being called to appear?

**Answer:**

- Yes. This is integral to the fair and efficient conduct of the inquiry.
- ABCC notices must comply with the *Building and Construction Industry Improvement Regulations Amendment Regulations 2005 (No 1)*.
- The notices must contain information about the address to which the contravention relates, the building industry participant involved, the law that has allegedly been contravened and the period during which the contravention took place.
