Original budget in application for funding for the Enterprise Hubs included the following staffing costs for year one for 11 staff:

Capacity Building Unit:

Facilitators/Redfern (2)	\$80,256

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Trainer/Redfern + Mt Druitt	\$40,128
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Admin Support Unit:

Management supervision	\$40,000
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Admin/finance/audit support	\$32,000
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Receptionist/Redfern 2.5 days	\$14,164
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Receptionist/Mt Druitt 2.5 days	\$14,164
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Shine Unit:

Program facilitators (2)	<u>\$80,256</u>
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Total	\$381,224
