#### Question:

Part-time Australian Postgraduate Awards

1. Can you tell me how many higher degree students are in receipt of part-time Australian Postgraduate Awards?
2. What percentage is this of the total?
3. What criteria must a student fulfil to be eligible to hold an APA on a part-time basis?
4. To qualify, do they need to have a disability or face significant demands as a carer?
5. When was the issue of the taxation of part-time APAs last raised with the Department?
6. Is the Department considering approaching the ATO with a view to resolving this anomaly – because full-time APAs are not subject to income tax?
7. Has the Department held discussions with other relevant departments and/or agencies about the policy link between this issue and that of the Government's "Welfare to Work" initiative?
8. What has been the outcome of any such discussions?

#### Answer:

*Part-time Australian Postgraduate Awards*

1. 923 students received a part-time APA in 2005.
2. 17%.

5. The issue was raised with government in 2002.
6. No. The department has addressed the different taxation status of part-time and full-time APA awards by including an additional amount in the part-time rate to ensure that the award holders receive, after tax, half the full-time rate, and are thus not disadvantaged in terms of funding support. APA stipend rates for 2007 are \$19,616 for full-time students and \$10,480 for part-time students.
