National Literacy and Numeracy strategies and projects - Reading Voucher Assistance Programme

- 1. What is the cost of the Reading Voucher Assistance Program? Including cost of rolling over the program for a 12 month period?
- 2. What performance indicators are in place to assess the program's effectiveness?
- 3. Has there been a difference in take-up rates by States, regions? What factors underpin these differences?
- 4. Please list all current providers and where are they located? Has there been a change in providers over the running of this program?

Answer:

National Literacy and Numeracy strategies and projects - Reading Voucher Assistance Programme

- 1. \$20.6 million over the 2006-07 and 2007-08 financial years. This programme will deliver all tuition in the 2007 school year.
- 2. The performance indicator for the programme is a verifiable improvement in students reading skills, as measured by, but not limited to the results of pre- and post-tuition assessment; and other evidence such as parents'/caregivers' and tutors' comments and judgements.
- 3. Tuition delivery will occur in the 2007 school year. Take-up rates by states, regions will not be available until the completion of the programme.
- 4. Tuition under the Reading Assistance Voucher programme has not commenced and tutors are currently still registering to participate.
