Accelerated Learning Program

There was an advertisement for a consultant in the Koori Mail on Dec 6th to evaluate and report on the Yachad Accelerated Learning Program.

- 1. Has the consultant been selected and if so could we know who it is?
- 2. Is this the only evaluation which will have been carried out on the entire project in 3 years?
- 3. When is the evaluation report due to be finished?
- 4. What has the expenditure on this program been to date? To whom are the funds released?
- 5. One of the sites was Yipirinya School in Alice Springs. When did YALP go in there?
- 6. How many students have been involved?
- 7. What has been taught just English or any of the 4 other languages of the students at that school?
- 8. Which teachers were used on the program at Yipirinya?

- 1. The consultant selected is Phillips KPA.
- 2. This is the first independent evaluation arranged by DEST since the commencement of the project.
- 3. The final report is due in mid 2007.
- 4. \$2.3 million (excl. GST). Payments have been to the Yachad Accelerated Learning Project Ltd (YALP Ltd) and HTT Associates (prior to YALP Ltd being formed).
- 5. YALP commenced operation at Yipirinya School in Alice Springs in Term 1, 2006.
- 6. Forty-three students were involved at Yipirinya School in Alice Springs during 2006.
- 7. Teaching is conducted in English.
