The performance of the national collections is assessed on the basis of:

- Contribution to the field of taxonomic research nationally and internationally as indicated by peer reviewed scientific output;
- Contribution to broader research fields, as evidenced by involvement in research projects on other research programs or externally to CSIRO; and
- Relevance as indicated by the level of use of the collections both internally to CSIRO and externally.
