Senator Carr asked on 14 February 2007, EWRE Hansard page 117.

Question:

Senator CARR— How many students in full fee undergraduate places in publicly funded universities have so far availed themselves of FEE-HELP?

Senator CARR— Are you able to give me a breakdown on that for each of the institutions?

Answer:

FEE-HELP – full fee undergraduate students

In 2005, the latest year for which final data is available, 3,396 domestic undergraduate students at public higher education providers (Table A providers) used FEE-HELP. The figure of 3,476 students quoted at the hearings counted students enrolled in a cross-institutional course for each of the providers in which they were enrolled. The revised figure, which also includes some data revisions submitted by higher education providers and processed since the hearings, counts each student enrolled on a cross-institutional basis with more than one provider only once.
