## Answer:

From 1 July 2006 to 23 February 2007:
a) 215,546 Participation Reports have been received by Centrelink from providers of Australian Government employment services.
b) As a result 103,503 failures were applied by Centrelink.
c) Data on reviews and appeals is not publicly available.

g) 7,454 job seekers had an eight week non-payment period applied by Centrelink as a result of a serious failure or a third participation failure.
