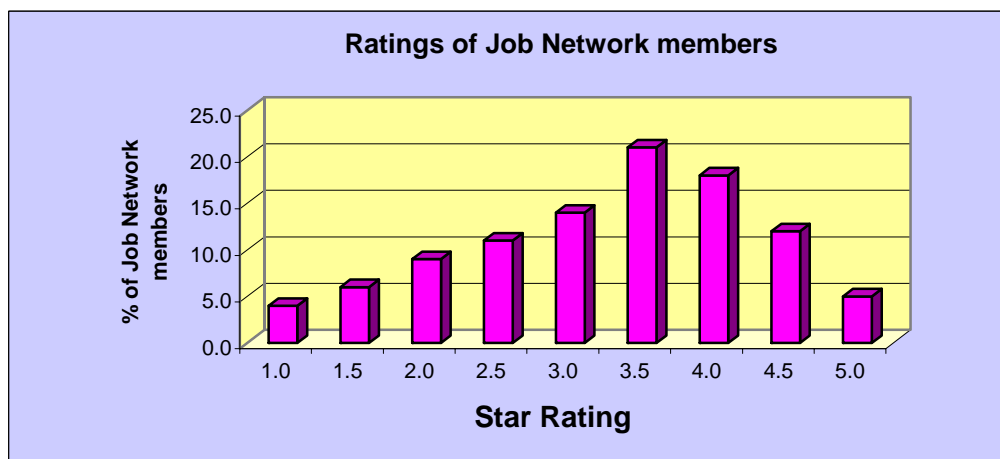
**Question:**

Senator Wong asked in writing:

What is the average national Star Rating?

**Answer:**

There is no 'average' Star Rating for Job Network members. Star Ratings are awarded on the basis of relative performance across Job Network sites and Employment Services Areas in accordance with the following distribution chart. Fifty six per cent of sites receive a 3.5 Star Rating or better.
