Senator Wong asked: In relation to W992-07 can you explain what arrangements are in place in each state to quickly assess a person's eligibility as a principal carer?

Answer:

Centrelink assesses a person's eligibility as a principal carer based on the *Social Security Act 1991*. This is a Commonwealth Act and therefore applies consistently across all states and territories.

Further questions on how the assessment of principal carer status takes place should be addressed to Centrelink.
