Senator Wong asked in writing:

Unlawful Termination Assistance Scheme Does DEWR keep records about the details of applicants? eg a) sector b) wage/salary level c) classification.

Answer:

Details about applicants, such as annual income, employer name, and date of termination, are collected by the Department for the purposes of determining the applicant's eligibility under the Scheme. Information that does not assist the Department make an assessment of the application (such as the industry sector and the employee's classification) is not collected.
