Senator Wong asked in writing:

**Unlawful Termination Assistance Scheme** How many applicants to the scheme have lodged an appeal against a rejection for funding? On what grounds have these applicants appealed? How many of these appeals have been successful?

**Answer:**

As at 28 February 2007, four requests for review have been received. One of these requests was subsequently withdrawn by the applicant.

The primary ground for appeal is consideration by the Department that the applicant's circumstances warrant special consideration.

All were found to be eligible upon review.
