Senator Crossin asked at *Hansard* page 47:

In answer to W808-07 of November 2006 I asked how many organisations in the NT had DEWR visited and assisted with Capacity Building plans. The answer was that DEWR could not answer this at an organisational level as it is commercial in confidence. Could you explain to me clearly why having help in developing capacity building plans is either commercial or in confidence?

**Answer:**

As detailed in the response to W808-07, Capacity Building Plans have been discussed with all CDEP service providers in the Northern Territory.
