For the period 1 July 2007 to 31 December 2007, the number of job seekers who volunteered to do Work for the Dole compared to those who undertook Work for the Dole to fulfill their Mutual Obligation (MO) requirements are:

- NSA/Youth Allowance job seekers aged over 18 years
- Parenting Payment recipients whose youngest child is less than 6 years
- Disability Support Pension recipients (work capacity minimum of 8 hours a week)
- Personal Support Programme and Disability Employment Network participants
