### Question:

**STEP** 

How successful has the program been rated?

#### Answer:

There have been 7,684 training and employment commencements under Structured Training and Employment Projects (STEP) from 1 July 2007 to 29 February 2008. This compares to total of 5,116 commencements in the full year of 2006-07.

Performance data on Structured Training and Employment Projects (STEP) is collected and reported through the department's Post Program Monitoring (PPM) Survey. The PPM measures outcomes achieved by job seekers three months after they exit labour market assistance. In the 12 months to 31 December 2007, the PPM Survey shows job seekers who exited STEP assistance between 01 October 2006 and 30 September 2007 achieved the following outcomes:

Full-time employment 51.5%
Part-time employment 15.9%
Total Employed 67.5%
Positive outcomes\*\* 72.7%
