Question

Australian Technical Colleges

Senator WORTLEY—Can you provide details of the tuition fees payable for each course in each ATC?

Mr Johnson—We could take that on notice.

Answer

Each Australian Technical College has determined its own fee structure. These generally do not vary according to courses undertaken. Fees are usually on per student, per annum basis.

A list of fees charged by each ATC is provided below:

ATC	Student Fees (per student per annum)
Adelaide South	Standard non-compulsory fee \$350, with an additional compulsory materials fee of \$250.
Bendigo	\$450. In addition \$150 charged by RTO for the trade training component.
Central Coast	\$400.
Darwin	No fees are charged by the College. Fees may be charged by partner schools for academic studies.
Central Western NSW (previously Dubbo)	\$500. Scholarships available for students in need.
Eastern Melbourne	\$500. In addition, students are expected to purchase stationery and text books.
Geelong	\$400. (\$100 Concession). Materials and resource fee: \$210. Extra-curricula fee: \$250.
Gippsland	\$250.
Gladstone	\$750.
Gold Coast	\$1700 (Year 11) and \$1500 (Year 12).
Hunter	School fee: \$350.00. Enrolment fee: \$50.00. Resource fee: \$250.00. Book hire fee: \$100.00.
Illawarra	\$520.
North Brisbane	No tuition fee. Application fee \$65. Resources fee \$800 per semester.
North Queensland	\$600.
Northern Adelaide	\$950 (Year 11) and \$735 (Year 12).
Northern Tasmania	\$300. Industry sponsors are sought for

	scholarships.
Perth South	\$950.
Pilbara	Nil.
Port Macquarie	\$1797. Family discounts apply.
Queanbeyan	\$720.
Spencer Gulf and Outback	\$500. Resources fee \$200, with discounts for disadvantaged students.
Sunshine	\$250.
Wannon	No tuition fees. Students pay for uniforms (approx \$200 per year). RTOs charges up to \$301.
Western Sydney	\$1,650.
