Question

Cost of child care

Does the Department keep any record of the average cost of child care in the different states and different regions?

Answer

The Department collects fee information via the mychild.gov.au website. This information is supplied voluntarily by child care providers, and is available to the public via the searchable database on the website.

The Department has undertaken analysis of the fee information provided by services. Table 1 contains the average reported daily fee for each state and territory, by remoteness classification. These fees were current as at July 31 2008.
