Question

Transitional and Consequential Bill

What consultation will there be with stakeholders who may not be part of COIL?

Answer

The Committee on Industrial Legislation (COIL) is a sub-committee of the National Workplace Relations Consultative Council (NWRCC). COIL has previously been made up of representatives from the Australian Council of Trade Unions and the Australian Chamber of Commerce and Industry.

As with the Fair Work Bill, consultation on the draft transitional and consequential arrangements occurred with an expanded meeting of the COIL.

During the consultation on the transitional and consequential arrangements, representatives from Master Builders Australia, the National Farmers' Federation, the Australian Industry Group, the Business Council of Australia, the Australian Mines and Metals Association, the Australian Hotels Association and the Housing Industry Association were included.
