Question

Representation for the inclusion of superannuation under GEERS

Senator ABETZ—Yes. I was putting to you last time that it was only from the trade union movement, as I recall. I said: In response to question 203, you say that unions and other stakeholders have made representations in relation to the inclusion of superannuation. Can you provide on notice a list of those stakeholders and the nature of their representation? I agree that telling us about the nature of the representations may well have been a huge use of resources, I accept that, but just naming who some of those stakeholders might have been, other than the trade unions, I would have thought would have been a helpful response, and you have not named any other stakeholder other than trade unions.

Mr Kovacic—If you would like us to go away and get two or three examples of each of those sorts of stakeholders referred to in the second paragraph, I am prepared to take that on notice, but in terms of doing a forensic search around all of the representations.

Senator ABETZ—I accept that. But I am continually told 'a variety of stakeholders' and when I ask you name unions. I then put it on notice and we are told 'a variety of stakeholders including', and then once again we just get a list of unions. So if you can take that on notice again I would be much obliged.

Mr Kovacic—All right.
