Question

ABCC - External Prosecution Agencies

- 1. Who within the ABCC is responsible for dealing with the relevant external prosecution agency, e.g. police or DPP, where a decision is made that an ABCC matter be referred for prosecution?
- 2. Who within the ABCC was ultimately responsible for the decision to refer the Setka/Hudson matter for prosecution?

Answer

The Office of the Australian Building and Construction Commissioner has provided the following response:

- 1. Depending on the particular circumstances, a decision to refer a matter to an external law enforcement agency (i.e. make a formal complaint) will be made by the victim, supported by and in conjunction with senior management at the ABCC.
- 2. The affected ABC Inspectors made complaints to Victoria Police in their personal capacity.
