Question

SWA - penalties in New South Wales prior to the new regime

Senator FIFIELD: Could you please take on notice what the penalties were in New South Wales prior to the new regime. Mr Hoy: We have a table of all those provisions preharmonisation, which we can make available to the committee. Senator FIFIELD: Do you have that with you at the moment? Ms Ross: We have the table of all the provisions, but it does not contain the penalties. We can insert the penalty levels into that table. Senator FIFIELD: I am a little surprised, given the public debate that there has been about penalties, that you do not have that to hand, but I appreciate you taking that on notice. Will the table that you provide have the penalties that were existing in the cases of New South Wales? Mr Hoy: We have them, but we do not have them in a particular table we can easily hand over. Senator FIFIELD: Will that also have how volunteers were described in the pre-existing legislation? In other jurisdictions, were they called other persons in the workplace or some other term? It might vary from legislation to legislation. Ms Ross: Yes.
