Family day care educators

Senator BACK: Do they advise family day carers if English is their second language? Is that information you collate? Mr De Silva: I am not entirely sure we do collect that information from family day care educators. Ms Taylor: But it may be in the national workforce census. Senator BACK: It would be interesting to know. It would be interesting to know the proportion of carers that might have a language other than English as well.

Answer

The 2010 Early Childhood Education and Care (ECEC) National Workforce Census did not collect information on the Language Other Than English (LOTE) status of ECEC staff and carers.
